November in the VINA project has passed under the sign of multiplier events. They took place in each partner country with a purpose of a direct dissemination and creating a space, where people can meet our consortium, learn about many aspects of VINA project and be guided through our website.

Multiplier events were held in big cities like Athens, Palermo, Manchester, Prague and Słupsk and met a lot of interest. Participants formed a very diverse group of people such as academics, lecturers, teachers, trainers, social activists and students of various degrees.



In general events were divided into two parts: presentation and workshops. Lectures were dedicated to topics linked to Erasmus+, non-formal and informal education, need of skills validation and goals of VINA project. Workshops were a great opportunity for participants to see how VINA Database and ROTA work and learn about the use and functions of project outputs. Events ended with a questions and answers session time or direct discussions with organisers inter alia about plans or ideas for further development of the platform. In addition, participants of the event received promotional materials about the VINA project such as leaflets, brochures and pens.

The overall feedback from participants was very positive. They were interested in exploring the database which recognised as a very needful and helpful device, an option of adding new tools was particularly appreciated. A lot of the attendees express their interest to receive more information on the progress of the platform and most of them reported that they will use it in the future. Attendees gave also a positive evaluation about the contents and the competence of the speakers.
